

## **DORC Meeting Minutes 4-06-07**

**Meeting open at 7:00pm**

**Previous minutes:**

As per emails the previous meeting minutes had been read and accepted by committee members via email.

**Agenda items:**

**1) Trail reports**

Kyle Bawden states there is nothing new to report to the committee. All new tracks for Holmes Jungle are still with Dal Hartley / Parks & Wildlife for approval.

**2) Money / grants / equipment**

- Tim reports the grant from Ground Effect has been approved 'in principle'. He is currently pricing culverts, etc and talking to Dal Hartley re Parks & Wildlife requirements for works in Charles Darwin Park. This is for the style, width, type of construction, etc for bridges. The proposed area for the initial works is the low area when you first turn off the bitumen near the fire hydrant (exit road). This is to stop environmental damage during wet season use.
- The Optus sponsorship has been placed in the DORC account. Kyle is to purchase the banner for races. Quotes have previously been discussed.
- The Community Benefit Fund (CBF) has been placed in the DORC account.
  - Timing gear – Emma is to purchase timing gear to the value of approx \$500 (lap counter/printer and stopwatch).
  - Trailer – Kyle is to get further information on this. Jon Presswell has been sidetracked with a wedding.
- First Aid Kit – Aaron was to get a price on a custom kit. Peter to email him a reminder as is required before next race. Emma also states she is a qualified first aid practitioner.
- Shade structure – Aaron was to get a price on a 3x3m structure. Peter to email him a reminder.

**3) Skills / maintenance workshop**

Kyle and Jon presented a 45min workshop on basic mtb skills. Approx 15-18 people took advantage of this and all had a good time from reports. Kyle also wants to present a basic maintenance workshop. He will find someone to deliver this session.

**4) Finances**

Emma reports there are now 86 financial members. There is a total of \$6784 in the account (after grants have been deposited).

**5) Next meeting**

The next meeting will be 7pm Monday July 2<sup>nd</sup>.
